A car is highly recommended in order to best explore the resort area.

The drive from Carlisle to Dailly takes approximately 3 hours. Follow M6 Motorway north from Carlisle, which continues north onto the A74. Then take M74 to Junction 12 and turn left onto A70. Follow this road to Ayr, then take A77 to Maybole. At Maybole, turn left at the "Cassellis Hotel" onto the B7023 to Crosshill. Drive through Crosshill, turning right at the "Crosshill Arms" onto the B741 to Dailly. Upon reaching Dailly, turn at the 1st right and drive through the village. Bear to the right at the end of the village. Drive over a bridge, then take your 1st left onto Golf Course road. Follow the road alongside the golf course, then turn right at Brunston Avenue. The reception area is situated inside the leisure centre on the left side at the top of the hill.
